

Admissions Requirements

International Students from Gambia, Nigeria and other West African Nations

MINIMUM ADMISSIONS REQUIREMENTS FOR WAEC West African Senior School Certificate Examination

International students graduating from Ghana, Nigeria, Sierra Leone, Liberia, and the Gambia High School system must satisfy the following requirements:

- Must provide official WAEC transcript awarded by the West African Examination Council
- The general admission requirements are B average on the 40% passing scale (see scale below)
- School transcripts in any language other than English must be accompanied by a certified translation.
- 4. All International Students must also meet the College's English Language Standard.

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ADMISSION STANDARD

- 1. TOEFL: A minimum score of 550 (PBT) or 83 (iBT)
- 2. IELTS: A minimum overall band test score of 6.5 (academic module only)
- 3. EIKEN: A minimum placement of Grade 1 on the Test in Practical English
- 4. A minimum overall and essay score of "60" on the Canadian Academic English Language Assessment (CAEL) or CAEL CE or CELPIP 2 will be accepted as a substitution to English 12 "C"
- Provide proof of enrollment in a college-level writing or literature course that transfers as a college level English or a Communications or a Creative Writing course
